International seminar in Brno to take place soon

As part of the planned military education exchange programme - Military Erasmus - the Brno University of Defence organises an international seminar on 20-22 April 2009. The seminar will take place at the Bobycentrum Hotel (Sportovní 2a, Královo Pole). The event, which will be attended by more than 60 foreign and 20 national delegates, is organised under the auspices of the Minister of Defence and belongs to the key activities of the Ministry of Defence of the Czech Republic during the Czech EU Presidency.

The key topic of the April international Military Erasmus seminar will be the issue of student and teacher mobility as one of the ways to enhance European education and culture in security and defence. The shared objective of all universities participating in the Military Erasmus programme should be the establishment of a qualification that is comprehensible, mutually comparable and respected in all Member States.
